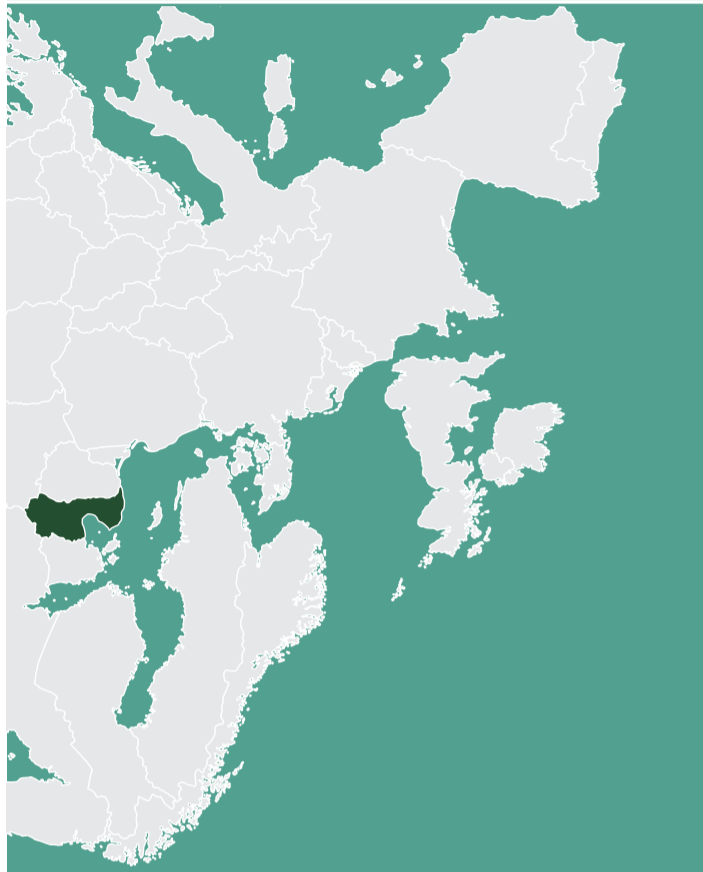

Riga

Kemer National Park

Sigulda

Ligatne

A wild animal sanctuary, a series of caves inhabited by wine-makers and craftsmen, and a park in which every sculpture is carved out of wood. Nature is all around.



Cesis

Aglona Basilica

A pivotal pilgrimage site cherished by the Catholic community, this is where you pause, stepping out of the relentless hustle and daily grind. Take a pause to reflect on what truly matters.



Rundale Palace

Time flies at the Baltics' grandest palace - the 18th century residence of the Dukes of Courland. Wander through the opulent chambers and be bewitched by the alluring rose garden.



Kuldiga

Town Kuldiga charms with its UNESCO World Heritage-listed Old Town, where the magic unfolds with the thrilling springtime spectacle of fish attempting to leap over Europe's widest waterfall, known as "Ventas Rumba".



Liepaja

The largest historical military territory in the Baltics, remains of forts, Art Nouveau and wooden architecture, beaches, the largest unreconstructed mechanical pipe organ in the world and 17th-19th century interior museum are some of the city's main attractions.



Ventspils

This family-friendly city is well known for its cow sculptures, white sand beaches, amusement parks, Vizion Science Center and arrow-gauge railway at the open-air museum.



Baltic Sea Coast

From white sand beaches to rugged sandstone cliffs to secluded pebble beaches, find your favourite part of our 500 km-long coastline!



Daugavpils

Explore the 19th-century Daugavpils Fortress, originally built in anticipation of Napoleon's invasion. Today, sections of the fortress have been restored, offering history exhibitions, an art gallery, and the cutting-edge Rothko Museum - legendary painter Mark Rothko was born in this city.



Lake Region
